Monthly Shipment Comparison

National Trends

In November 2023, 7,769 new manufactured homes were produced, a decrease of 624 homes or 7.4 percent compared to October 2023, and a decrease of 201 homes or 2.5 percent compared to November 2022. MHI's Monthly Economic Report includes numbers for both manufactured home production and shipments. The difference between the two is attributed to the number of homes that have been produced, but their destinations are pending. Of the homes produced, 86 were FEMA designated units shipped to Maryland.

The number of plants reporting production in November 2023 was 147 and the number of active corporations was 36, the same number of plants and corporations as in the prior two months.

In November 2023, 7,751 new manufactured homes were shipped, a decrease of 632 homes or 7.5 percent compared to October 2023, and a decrease of 247 homes or 3.1 percent compared to November 2022. Compared with the same month last year, shipments of single-section homes were down by 8.5 percent, while shipments of multi-section homes were up by 1.8 percent. Total floors shipped in November 2023 were 12,106, a decrease of 156 floors or 1.3 percent compared with the same month last year.

The seasonally adjusted annual rate (SAAR) of shipments was 92,839 in November 2023, down 2.8 percent compared to the adjusted rate of 95,559 in October 2023. The SAAR corrects for normal seasonal variations and projects annual shipments based on the current monthly total.

Cumulative shipments through November this year totaled 82,784 homes compared with 106,454 homes for the same 11 months of 2022, a net decrease of 22.2 percent.

State and Regional Results

Shipment results for November 2023 showed increases for 20 states and decreases in 30 states. Top shipment increases and decreases (ranked by change in the number of shipments) are shown below.

Top Shipment Changes by State – NOVEMBER

Compared with the same month last year, in November 2023 shipments losses were posted in six regions, while shipments gains were posted in three regions. New England had the largest proportional decrease in shipments, down 38.9 percent compared with November 2022. The South Atlantic states reported the smallest proportional increase in shipments, up 9.3 percent compared with November 2022, while the East South Central states realized the largest proportional increase in shipments, up 23.3 percent.




