



Industry Production, Shipments and Trends



## Manufactured Housing Institute's Monthly Economic Report MARCH 2024



#### **National Trends**

In March 2024, 8,447 new manufactured homes were produced, an increase of 92 homes or 1.1 percent compared to February 2024, and an increase of 801 homes or 10.5 percent compared to March 2023. MHI's Monthly Economic Report includes numbers for both manufactured home production and shipments. The difference between the two is attributed to the number of homes that have been produced, but their destinations are pending. There were no FEMA units produced in March 2024.

The number of plants reporting production in March 2024 was 148 and the number of active corporations was 36, the same number of plants and corporations as in the prior month.

In March 2024, 8,464 new manufactured homes were shipped, an increase of 117 homes or 1.4 percent compared to February 2024, and an increase of 799 homes or 10.4 percent compared to March 2023. Compared with the same month last year, shipments of single-section and multi-section homes were up, by 11.7 percent and 9.4 percent, respectively. Total floors shipped in March 2024 were 13,166, an increase of 1,187 floors or 9.9 percent compared with the same month last year.

The seasonally adjusted annual rate (SAAR) of shipments was 102,924 in March 2024, up 0.5 percent compared to the adjusted rate of 102,386 in February 2024. The SAAR corrects for normal seasonal variations and projects annual shipments based on the current monthly total.

Cumulative shipments through March this year totaled 24,272 homes compared with 21,162 homes for the same three months of 2023, a net increase of 14.7 percent.

#### **State and Regional Results**

Shipment results for March 2024 showed increases for 23 states and decreases in 24 states, while three states remained unchanged. Top shipment increases and decreases (ranked by change in the number of shipments) are shown below.

Compared with the same month last year, in March 2024 shipments losses were posted in five regions, while shipments gains were posted in four regions. The East North Central region reported the largest proportional decrease in shipments, down 29.3 percent compared with March 2023. The West North Central states reported the smallest proportional increase in shipments, up 3.2 percent compared with March 2023, while the East South Central states realized the largest proportional increase in shipments, up 48.6 percent.




