

# **HUD Installer Application Instructions**

## How to apply for a HUD Installer License

To install homes in any state where HUD administers the Installation Program, you must apply for a HUD Installer License.

### **Online Submission**

#### **Paper Submission**

To submit a paper application, you must fill out the HUD 307 Manufactured Home Installer License Application with all required supplemental information.

Make sure to fill out the forms entirely with accurate information, legible handwriting and signature of the applicant.

### **Required Supporting Documents**

When you submit the application through any method you must include the following:

- 1. Proof of taking and passing an approved training course.
- 2. A copy of your general liability insurance policy with HUD listed as an additional insured, and a Bond or Irrevocable Letter of Credit. Additional insured address is below:

- 3. When not self-certifying, provide proof of experience or education.
- 4. All other applicable licenses or certifications to install manufactured homes.
